RESOLUTION REGARDING TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY ANNUAL COMMUNITY EVENTS

WHEREAS, the City/Village of Melean sponsors parade races, festivals and other such events which constitute a public purpose; and,	30 rand
WHEREAS, many of these events are hold a public purpose; and,	, 10au

WHEREAS, many of these events are held on State rights-of-way which will require the temporary closure of said highways; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., authorizes the State of Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) to issue public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCILVILLAGE BOARD OF THE CITY COUNCILVILLAGE MCLEAN, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1

The City Council/Village Board requests an annual permit allowing the temporary closure of State highways for the purpose of conducting various parades, road races, festivals, and other such events. By receiving an annual permit, the City/Village will be required to notify the Department in writing approximately ten (10) days in advance of all road closures so that emergency agencies will be notified of the proposed event.

SECTION 2

- (A) That traffic from the closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept that anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State highway, except as provided in Subsections (B) and (C) hereof.
- (B) That when a marked detour is not provided, police officers or authorized flaggers shall, at the expense of the **CHAN**, be positioned at each end of the closed section of roadway and at other points as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the temporary detour.
- (C) That when the roadway is closed for less than 15 minute, police officers, at the expense of the willage of MCLFAP, shall stop traffic for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes and an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that traffic may pass through.

SECTION 3
That the McLAD assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect.
Section 4
That all debris shall be removed by the City/Village of McLEAN prior to reopening the State highway.
SECTION 5
That the closure and detour shall be marked according to the <u>Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices</u> (MUTCD).
SECTION C
SECTION 6
That the MCLEAN hereby agrees to assume all liabilities and pay all claims for any damage which shall be occasioned by the closing described above and to hold harmless the State of Illinois from all claims arising from the requested road closings.
SECTION 7
That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Illinois Department of Transportation; District 5 Bureau of Operations, 13473 IL Hwy. 133, P. O. Box 610, Paris, Illinois 61944-0610 to serve as authorization for the to request highway closures through December 31, 2014.
