RESOLUTION NO. 14-10-06R

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF A BINDING PUBLIC QUESTION CONCERNING WHETHER THE VILLAGE OF MCLEAN SHALL BECOME A HOME RULE UNIT TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT OF THE ELECTORS OF SUCH VILLAGE AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 7, 2015

WHEREAS, the Village of McLean (the "Village"), is a duly incorporated and existing non-home rule municipality, created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution, Article VII, Section 6(a), provides that the Village may become a home rule unit by referendum; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village that there shall be submitted, to the qualified electors of the Village, a binding public question concerning whether the Village should become a home rule unit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MCLEAN, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The President and Board of Trustees of the Village find and determine that all of the recitals contained in the whereas paragraphs of this Resolution are full, true and correct and are incorporated by reference into this Resolution.

SECTION 2: That the proposition hereinafter set forth be submitted to the voters of the Village at the General Election to be held on Tuesday, the 7th day of April, 2015, (the "Election").

SECTION 3: That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the McLean County Clerk (the "County Clerk") for voters of the Village at the Election.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: That the County Clerk shall give notice of the Election in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 5: That the Village Clerk shall post a copy of the Notice at least ten (10) days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the Village.

SECTION 6: That the ballot to be used at the Election shall be in substantially the same form as is set forth below, and shall meet the requirements of Articles 24A, 24B or 24C of the Election Code if an electronic, mechanical or electric voting system is used at the Election in McLean County:

SECTION 7: That the Election shall be conducted by the election judges appointed by the County Clerk to act in the voting precincts at which said proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the Village.

SECTION 8: That after the adoption hereof and not less than sixty-eight (68) days prior to the date of the Election, or Thursday, January 29, 2015, the Village Clerk shall file with the County Clerk a certified copy of this Resolution in order that the binding proposition set forth herein may be submitted to the voters of the Village. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Resolution, and a certified copy of this Resolution, and shall be substantially in the form of EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 9: The Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/1, et seq.).

SECTION 10: The Village Clerk shall, within forty-five (45) days after the referendum, or May 22, 2015, file with the Secretary of State a certified statement showing the results of the referendum and the resulting status of the Village as a home rule unit or a non-home rule unit, in accordance with the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/28-8.

SECTION 11: That all ordinances, orders and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
